

## CYOR 2016-17 Season - Playoffs Format -Consolation Year-End Bonspiel

The final aggregate standing at the conclusion of the last round robin (March 14<sup>th</sup>) determines the teams who qualify to play for the Club Championship and the Consolation Year-End Bonspiel.

The top eight (8) teams in the aggregate team standings (based on points accumulated in all two (2) round robins will qualify for the Club Championship Playoffs to determine the Club Champion who then qualifies to represent the Club at the OCA Travelers' Club Championships.

Teams ranked 9 to 30 will play in a 22 team, four event bonspiel format where four winners and finalists will be awarded prize money (A, B, C and D). All teams participating in the Consolation Event will be seeded (1 to 22) based on their cumulated points total and are guaranteed three (3) games.

Playoffs will be held between March 21<sup>st</sup> and April 21<sup>st</sup>.

### Rules for all games except the Finals

- All games will be 8 ends. If tied after 8 ends a draw to the button with sweeping will be used to determine the winner.
- Game times are posted on the draw. Start time of 8:40pm game on any sheet may be altered depending on circumstances resulting from first game on that sheet.
- Time limit is 1 hour and 50 minutes. No end may start after 1 hour and 50 minutes. A draw to the button with sweeping will be used to determine the winner if tied when time limit comes into effect. If ice is not ready at 8:40pm teams will have 1 hour and 50 minutes from altered start time.
- The highest seeded team in each game has a choice of hammer or rock colour.
- Spare rule will remain the same as the regular season.

## CHAMPIONSHIP NIGHT RULES- *The Finals* – Friday April 21, 2017

- Games will be 8 ends. Start time will be 6:45pm for all games. Date and start time will not be altered for any reason.
- There is NO time limit.
- The higher seeded teams in each event will have the choice of hammer or rock colour.
- If tied after 8 ends a full end towards the glass will be played. If still tied, an additional end (or ends) will be played until winner is determined.
- Players must be from the official Team Roster. Any/all spares must be approved by the Convenor.
